THE COMMON APPLICATION	UNIVERSAL college APPLICATION	COALITION
Keeps a requirements tracker for each application, including each school's writing requirements.	Has an auto-save feature to prevent loss of information and the ability to edit essays after submission	Colleges must prove they provide substantial support to low-income and underrepresented students to use this platform.
Comes as a mobile application. Easy to preview application.	Students can link online content they've produced	Uses a locker tool, which allows students to store documents starting in 9 th grade. Features a collaboration space.

 Guide that walks you through the app from start to finish



Apply for financial aid

Your colleges will coordinate your federal, state, and college financial aid applications. All colleges participating in federal student aid programs need your FAFSA form. Be sure to complete this form to apply for federal aid. You can complete the <u>FAFSA</u> as early as October 1, 2020 at no cost to you or your family.

Your college may also offer financial aid. You may apply for college specific financial aid using the College Board's <u>CSS Profile</u> application or other college forms.

The <u>CSS Profile</u> application is available starting October 1, 2020 and has a filing fee. Some colleges may let you choose to complete the CSS Profile or a free application of their own. Check out each college's website for more guidance
